

Polystyrene Foam /Styrofoam®



- Expanded polystyrene foam (EPS) is polystyrene that has been expanded. Many people refer to it as Styrofoam[®] which is really just a commercial brand of insulation.
- It's often white but packing peanuts, meat trays and some cut vegetable bowls are black, green, blue or pink.
- PlanetCon will accept foam containers such as clamshells, plates, cups, bowls and egg cartons. Block foam and packaging foam is also accepted.
- Some foods, especially tomato-based ones leave a stain behind. This is fine as long as the items are relatively clean and dry.
- Expanded foam peanuts (Styrofoam peanuts) are accepted at PlanetCon but they must be bagged separately. <u>Make sure these are securely tied so they</u> <u>don't fly away in the breeze</u>.
